



MILFORD CARE CENTRE, Limerick **Serving the people of the Mid-West**

The Specialist Palliative Care Community Service (SPCCS) in Milford Care Centre is an interdisciplinary, community-based service providing specialist palliative care to adults and children living in Limerick, Clare, and North Tipperary. We strive to meet the patient and family where they are and develop a therapeutic relationship to help them to live within the confines of their palliative diagnosis with as good a quality of life as possible. We endeavour to facilitate end of life care at a place of their choosing and offer support and advice to family members choosing to care for patients at home at end of life.

The Nursing Team is an integral component of the service. Operating 7 days a week, the team works collaboratively with the primary care team caring for the patient (i.e., General Practitioners, Public Health Nurses, Community Intervention Team), to provide a holistic, specialist palliative care service that is responsive to patients changing health and wellbeing needs.

CNM III (Specialist Palliative Care Community Services) **Full time permanent post**

As part of the Nurse Management Governance structure, the CNM III works to manage, co-ordinate, and supervise patient care within a multidisciplinary setting, ensuring a high quality of patient care in a safe and caring environment. They:

- lead and manage the day-to-day activities of the Nursing Team in SPCCS.
- are responsible for the proactive and efficient coordination and management of activities and resources in a cost-effective manner.
- provide leadership and supervision in relation to patient care and caseload management, ensuring a high quality and timely care in a safe and caring environment.

Essential Qualifications: Candidates must:

- Be registered on the General Register of Nurses as maintained by NMBI.
- Have CNM 11 level / CNS level or its equivalent.
- Have a Post Graduate Qualification in Palliative Care.
- Have 5 years' experience in palliative nursing.
- Have clinical, managerial and administrative experience to fulfill the role.
- Demonstrate evidence of continuing professional development at the appropriate level.

Desirable Qualifications:

- A recordable post registration course in management or be willing to undertake training as required.
- Information System and Technology skills or be willing to undertake training as required.
